We are exhibiting members' artwork in a show with the theme: "The Artist's Muse". A muse is a person or personified force that is the source of inspiration for an artist. Viewers of artwork are always intrigued by what lies behind an artist's creation. Is it a particular artist's work, nature, one's spiritual life, life experiences, a person, an abstract ideal such as peace, freedom, beauty, love, unity, etc.? What inspired you to create the artwork?

Each member may submit up to two pieces of artwork for this show, along with 2-4 sentences explaining the "artist's muse" for the artwork. We did something similar for our last show at the Dehn Gallery: "Every Picture Tells a Story." The notes you submit with your registration will be printed and presented alongside your artwork. A glass display case supplied by the gallery will be available for 3-D artwork. Artwork can be not for sale. We are unsure yet about the gallery taking a commission or how much that would be. Check back for an update on the commission.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE is Thursday, July 12.

DROP-OFF Friday, July 13 from 10 am - 12 pm. Members may submit up to 2 pieces. Please attach a note to the back of each piece with your name and the name of the piece. Artwork must be securely framed. Use D-rings (preferred) or screw eyes and wire (no tooth hooks). Frames should be sturdy and well-constructed.
