Workshop Description

Using water based oils with palette knife and brushes, Lynette will demonstrate a landscape or seascape each day in an impressionistic style. Participants will then work to develop their own creativity in a loose style, focusing on color, composition, and design. This is a great opportunity to observe and practice a free, beautiful, compelling style of working with oils.



Artist's Bio

Lynette Goric studied at the University of Connecticut School of Fine Arts. She works primarily in oils, specializing in impressionistic landscapes. Her work concentrates on capturing atmospheric light and reflections, creating mood, and a sense of the ethereal. She is also an accomplished water-colorist.

"What I paint is an accumulation of what I have seen and felt in my life. I strive to create a sense of atmosphere, seeking the essence of the subject. There is a symmetry in my choices."

Lynette's theme of water and tree reflections has evolved into tonalism in recent landscapes done in oils. Elegant, with a sense of antiquity, these paintings bring the viewer into their depths with emotion and serenity. Pastoral scenes, marshes, seascapes, lake scenes and dramatic skies capture nature's elusiveness and the essence of a fleeting moment in time and place.
