Enjoy fun creative exercises, art techniques, and explorations in positive and negative design. We will use line, shape, pattern and enjoy creative play using a limited palette. We will cover three simple exercises - one drawing, one cut paper and one painting with lots of brush discovery. Participants will be supplied with materials. No experience necessary.



PRINTMAKING

This is a great opportunity to learn and explore methods and materials for printmaking. We will be printing on paper using three different techniques. Learn how to use carving tools and make stencils to create artwork. Blocks for carving, ink, and paper will be provided. You are welcome to bring your own papers or scrapbooking paper if you choose. All levels of artistic ability are welcome. Deborah will provide carving tools for your use.

ABOUT THE ARTIST

You may remember Deborah from a demonstration she did for MAA last fall. A Brooklyn original, she lives the creative life in the wooded hills of New England with her husband and two boys. An award-winning artist-designer who loves the mix of design, words, art and craft, her work is modern, sophisticated, graphic and bold. Deborah creates art using both digital and traditional methods. Her designs can be found on products such as rugs, wall art, ceramics, stationery, textiles and mobiles, and has been exhibited in numerous galleries and juried shows. She studied Textiles and Fashion design at FIT in New York, where she received her Millinery Certification, studying under hat legend, Ann Albrizio. Her hats were featured at New York's Henri Bendel. She has been featured in UPPERCASE Magazine and is carried by Minted, West Elm, CarpetVista of Sweden and home décor licensing companies.
