Laura Kinlock is a trained artist whose history with visual arts dates back to her college years. Laura attended the State University of New York (SUNY) at Oswego, where she double majored in photography and art history, but after graduating she pursued a career in counseling, including some work for social services. Now retired, Laura has been involved with the Stafford Arts Society, Arts Center East (Vernon) and MAA and has had a number of individual shows. Her artistic pursuits include photography, oils, watercolor and pastel - which she notes as her “first love”. Laura attributes her compositional ability to her studies at SUNY Oswego. “Photography taught me to compose,” she said “And now I work from my own photos.”
