This exhibit is open to artwork created with watercolor. Members may submit up to 4 pieces of artwork, which will be included in the exhibit as space allows. We will display artwork BOTH on our website and in-person at the Manchester Town Hall, so we need a photo of each piece for the website.

PLEASE NOTE: If you sell a piece of your artwork on display, you may remove it from the exhibit only if you replace it with a similar piece. You must notify one of the exhibit co-chairs before you make the change-out.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Tuesday, July 5, 2022

PHOTOGRAPH YOUR ARTWORK:

- Please photograph your work before you frame it. Make sure you are standing directly in front of the artwork when you take the photo so the edges are straight. Outside on a cloudy day or in the shade works well for lighting (lighting that doesn't cast a shadow).
- Please submit a JPG (picture) of your artwork that is at least 600 pixels on any side. Your photo should be at least 100k. Images from your phone or camera are usually just fine.
- Identify your image(s): lastnameFirstname1.jpg or lastnameFirstname2.jpg (if you're submitting 2 pieces). For example, larsonChris1.jpg.

ELIGIBILITY: This show is open to MAA dues-paid members only. Membership is \$35.00 per year. Call or email Deb Parker (eyework2much@aol.com, 860-997-0654) with membership questions. DROP OFF: Thursday, July 7 from 11 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. at Manchester Town Hall.

Please attach a note to the back of each piece with your name and the name of the piece. Artwork must be securely framed and ready to hang with screw eyes and wire (no tooth hooks). Inappropriately framed works are subject to refusal. Click https://www.manchesterart.org/framing for our framing guidelines. Each piece can be no larger than 36 inches in any dimension.
