- You may enter up to two works of art, not more than 22 inches on any side including frame, or enter one larger work. The large glass shelves by the doorway are also available for threedimensional works of art.
- Items submitted MUST BE ORIGINAL WORK DONE SOLELY BY THE ARTIST. All media accepted. Artwork must be able to be hung on the wall; no freestanding sculpture (small pieces may be displayed in the library's glass display cases).
- Please attach a note to the back of each piece with your name and the name of the artwork.
- Artwork must be securely framed and ready to hang with D-rings or screw eyes and wire (no tooth hooks or staples). Inappropriately framed works are subject to refusal.
- Click "Framing guidelines" at https://www.manchesterart.org/member-info to read our guidelines. MAA reserves the right to reject any entry upon submission if it's not properly framed.
- Interested buyers will be referred to you. A price list with artists' phone numbers will be at the library circulation desk.
