This exhibit is open to artwork created with watercolor. Members may submit up to 4 pieces of artwork, which will be included in the exhibit as space allows. This exhibit will be **both** virtual and in-person at the Manchester Town Hall, so we would like photos of your artwork to include on our website.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Monday, February 5. You may register up to pieces of artwork in this exhibit. **Each piece must be registered separately.**

PHOTOGRAPH YOUR ARTWORK:

- Please photograph your work **before** you frame it. Make sure you are standing directly in front of the artwork when you take the photo so the edges are straight. Outside on a cloudy day or in the shade works well for lighting (lighting that doesn't cast a shadow). Email your images to Chris Larson (larsonc3@gmail.com)
- Please submit a JPG (picture) of your artwork that is at least 600 pixels on any side. **Your photo should be at least 100k.** Images from your phone or camera are usually just fine.
- **If possible**, identify your image(s): lastnameFirstname1.jpg, lastnameFirstname2.jpg, etc. (if you're submitting more than one piece). For example, larsonChris1.jpg.

ELIGIBILITY: This show is open to MAA dues-paid members only. Membership is \$35.00 per year. Email Carolyn Gimbrone (bowbrone@aol.com) or Karen Waggoner (ktwaggs@cox.net) with membership questions. See <https://www.manchesterart.org/join-maa> for more details about being an MAA member.

DROP OFF: Thursday, February 8 from 11 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. at Manchester Town Hall.

- Please attach a note to the back of each piece with your name and the name of the piece.
- Artwork must be securely framed and ready to hang with screw eyes and wire (no tooth hooks).
- Inappropriately framed works are subject to refusal. See framing guidelines (<https://www.manchesterart.org/framing>).
- Each piece can be no larger than 36 inches in any dimension.

PICK UP: Thursday, April 11 from 11 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: If you sell your artwork on display, you may remove it from the exhibit only if you replace it with a similar piece. You must notify one of the exhibit co-chairs before making the change-out.
